

Dear Taxpayer:

This is in response to your request dated Jan. 15, 2016, regarding your tax-exempt status.

We issued you a determination letter in July 1980, recognizing you as tax-exempt under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c) (3).

Our records also indicate you're not a private foundation as defined under IRC Section 509(a) because you're described in IRC Sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi).

Donors can deduct contributions they make to you as provided in IRC Section 170. You're also qualified to receive tax deductible bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts under IRC Sections 2055, 2106, and 2522.

In the heading of this letter, we indicated whether you must file an annual information return. If a return is required, you must file Form 990, 990-EZ, 990-N, or 990-PF by the 15th day of the fifth month after the end of your annual accounting period. IRC Section 6033(j) provides that, if you don't file a required annual information return or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked on the filing due date of the third required return or notice.

WHEREAS, the Latino Learning Center sees an average of 450 adults annually that receive training in their various vocational and educational programs and their state licensed adult day care program serves many elderly and disabled clients to facilitate independent living; and,

On June 27, 2019, the Latino Learning Center will hold its inaugural Barbara Bush Legacy Award, which coincides with the Latino Learning Center's 40th Anniversary. The City of Houston commends the Latino Learning Center on four decades of tircless and outstanding work throughout local communities in providing educational services, adult care service and establishing housing for seniors and disabled persons.
